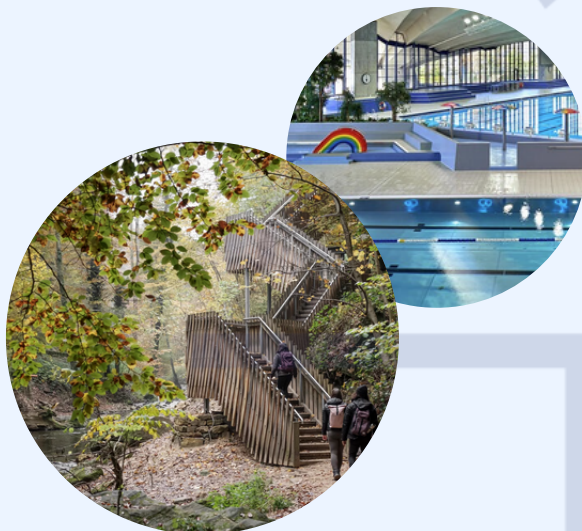

The Draï Eechelen is a museum located in the Kirchberg district of Luxembourg City, Luxembourg. Opened in July 2012 in Fort Thungen, an 18th-century building fully restored, its permanent exhibition traces the history of Luxembourg from 1443 to 1903.

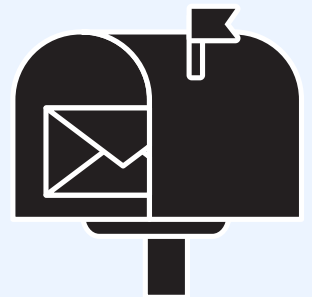
